Number 3 - All of us could take a lesson from the weather. It pays no attention to criticism.

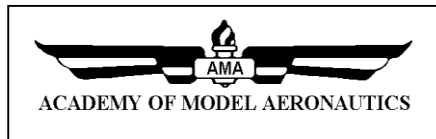
Number 2 - In the 60's, people took acid to make the world weird.
